



## **Annex 2 of the EPS Bylaws**

### **Duties of the Executive Committee of the EPS: The President**

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The duties of the President include (paragraph 10 of the Statutes):

The President of the Society oversees the implementation of resolutions of the General Assembly and of the Executive Committee and has legal representation, even representation of the case, as well as the signature of the Society within the limits which may be established in the appointment. (paragraph 10.1 of the Statutes)

The President shall call and chair the meeting of the General Assembly as well as of the Executive Committee of the EPS at least once a year.

The President shall submit an annual report to the General Assembly on the activities of the Executive Committee by May 31st.

The President shall sign the Minutes of the above meetings.

The President shall operate the account of the Society by the signatures jointly with the Treasurer or Secretary or shall delegate the Treasurer to administer the bank account opened at the name of the Society.

The General Assembly may at the absolute discretion of the President also make decisions by electronic voting, in particular for urgent issues that cannot wait for the next regular General Assembly meeting.
